It is never easy, especially when you must make complex decisions. There would have been 15 graduates; but the others were left on the road. Your financial help to me has allowed me to have fewer worries so the quality of teaching is greater.

We will never be able to know how many souls these faithful men will be influencing with the gospel of Jesus. Thank you for your prayers for them and for us and by 2025 we look forward to another harvest (the third) of more well-trained soldiers to go to the front lines.

Brothers, let us continue praying for the Lord to send more workers to his harvest, the cause of Christ demands it and much more in the current conditions in which our world is.
